Police:

Derek Reid, Police Officer, attended and reported that there were 49 incidents in the area of which the majority were mostly road traffic incidents, one possible theft of oil and theft of bag of wheels.

New Community School and Hub update:

- All progressing well, requirements list ongoing with feedback from hall users.
- Audit of use and potential use also under way.

Village Traffic and Access:

- Proposed pedestrian crossing adjacent to the Market Square – plan to be studied and will discuss at next meeting HF to find out when it will be shared with the wider Community.
- 30mph sign not working and has never worked in 3 years – HF to contact Robert Bruce about this.

Ashai g Cemetery

- Ashai g Cemetery is now full.
- Highland Council are saying that there are no funds to extend Ashai g Cemetery.
- It has been suggested that the car park may be suitable to use and change car parking area.
- Also to look at another potential site just past the current Cemetery.
- Community Payback scheme and volunteers cleared the paths.

Broadford Cemetery

- Work has started on the wall.
- Lairs are in a poor state.

Elgol Toilets:

- RTIF will be decided on the 4th of April.
- £3.5k from the Ward Discretionary Fund given to assist the Company in the first year.
- £200 per month will be paid from the Comfort Scheme.
- Fundraising will need to be organised to assist the Company with their liabilities.
